### **APPROVAL OF ENGAGEMENT LETTER WITH OCOTILLO LAW & POLICY PARTNERS FOR INTERIM CHAIRMAN OF THE MASHPEE WAMPANOAG TRIBAL GAMING COMMISSION**

**WHEREAS**, the Mashpee Wampanoag Tribe (the “Tribe”) is a federally-recognized Indian tribe with a duly-enacted Constitution;

**WHEREAS**, the Mashpee Wampanoag Tribal Council (the “Tribal Council”), the governing body of the Tribe, deems it essential under Article VI, § 2.A. of the Mashpee Wampanoag Tribal Constitution (“Constitution”) to promote and protect the political integrity, economic security and general welfare of the Tribe and members of the Tribe;

**WHEREAS**, Article VI, § 2.D. of the Constitution empowers the Tribal Council to negotiate and enter into contracts and agreements with state and local governments, private persons and corporate entities;

**WHEREAS**, in June 2017, the Tribal Council appointed Rory Dilweg as Interim Chairman of the Mashpee Wampanoag Tribal Gaming Commission; and

**WHEREAS**, Mr. Dilweg has since joined a new firm, Ocotillo Law & Policy Partners, and submitted an Engagement Letter to continue his service to the Tribe as specified therein (the “Engagement Letter”); and

**WHEREAS**, the Tribal Council desires to continue the appointment of Rory Dilweg as Interim Chairman of the Mashpee Wampanoag Tribal Gaming Commission; and

**WHEREAS**, the Tribal Council desires to approve the Engagement Letter to allow Mr. Dilweg to continue in his capacity as Interim Chairman; and

**WHEREAS**, the Tribal Council finds it in the best interests of the Tribe to express its authorization for the Tribal Council Chairman, or other authorized Tribal Council Chairman designee, to execute the Engagement Letter, and to take such other actions as are reasonable or necessary in furtherance of the execution or performance of such agreement.



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**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Tribal Council hereby approves of and authorizes in substantial conformity the Engagement Letter attached hereto as Exhibit A; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, nothing in this resolution or the Agreement shall be read or construed to effect, modify, limit, or waive the sovereign immunity of the MWT, its departments, agencies, organizations, officers, agents, employees and/or instrumentalities; and


**BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED**, that the Tribal Council authorizes the Tribal Council Chairman, or other Tribal Council Chairman designee, to execute the Agreement and to take such other actions as are reasonable and necessary in furtherance of the execution or performance of the Agreement; and

All resolutions or parts of resolutions inconsistent with this resolution are repealed. This resolution is effective immediately and shall continue pursuant to the authority vested in the Tribal Council pursuant to Article VI, §§ 2.A. and D. of the Constitution.


### CERTIFICATION

We, the undersigned Chairperson and Secretary of the Mashpee Wampanoag Tribal Council, do hereby certify that the Tribal Council is composed of 13 members of whom 11, constituting a quorum, were present at a meeting thereof, duly and regularly called, noticed, convened, and held on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of July, 2020, and that the foregoing resolution was duly adopted by the affirmative vote of 6 members, with 0 opposing, and with 5 not voting.
