TRIBAL COUNCIL RESOLUTION 2022-RES-057

RATIFICATION OF SUBMITTAL ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT ADMINISTRATION PUBLIC WORKS AND ECONOMIC ADJUSTMENT ASSISTANCE PROGRAMS GRANT – HAACP RENOVATION PROJECT

WHEREAS, the Mashpee Wampanoag Tribe (“Tribe”), is a federally recognized Indian Tribe with duly-enacted Constitution and the governing body of the Tribe is known as the Mashpee Wampanoag Tribal Council (“Tribal Council”); and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council, deems it essential under Article VI, § 2.A of the Mashpee Wampanoag Tribal Constitution (“Constitution”) to promote and protect the health, peace, morals, education, political integrity, economic security and general welfare of the Tribe and members of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article VI, § 2 of the Constitution, the Tribal Council is empowered to exercise certain powers, including the power to promote and protect the economic security and general welfare of the Tribe and its members, and the power to negotiate and enter into contracts with other governments and with private persons and corporate entities; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has received notice from Department of Commerce of a grant opportunity known as the EDA Public Works and Economic Adjustment Assistance Programs to assist indigenous communities in recovering economically from the negative and lasting impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic; and

WHEREAS, the Tribe seeks to pursue a grant opportunity for the Tribal Project to be known as the “HAACP Renovation Project” (the “HAACP Application”) to strengthen the Tribal economy; and

WHEREAS, the Tribe, on or about September 29, 2022, submitted the HAACP Application to the Department of Commerce/EDA for consideration; and

WHEREAS, the HAACP Application requests funding to support the operation, construction and management of the facility and shellfish farm it supports; and

WHEREAS, the HAACP Application proposes a budget as follows:

Direct Costs Total: 402,874.10 (estimated)
Indirect Costs Total: 107,016.17 (estimated)
Total Grant Budget: \$509,890.27 (estimated)

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council desires to affirm, confirm and ratify the approval and authorization of the submittal of the HAACP Application to the Department of Commerce/EDA for consideration.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Tribal Council hereby affirms, confirms and ratifies the approval and authorization to submit the HAACP Application to the Department of Commerce/EDA for consideration.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that the Tribal Council hereby affirms, confirms and ratifies authorization for the Tribal Chairman, or in his absence, other Tribal Council Officer, the requisite authority and power for an on behalf of the Tribe to take all necessary action to ensure the submission of the HAACP Application to the Department of Commerce/EDA is successful.

Effective immediately and until revoked or modified by the Tribal Council, pursuant to the authority vested in the Tribal Council pursuant to Article VI, Sections 2.A. and D. of the Constitution of the Mashpee Wampanoag Tribe.

All resolutions or parts of resolutions inconsistent with this resolution are repealed. This resolution is effective immediately and shall continue pursuant to the authority vested in the Tribal Council pursuant to Article VI, §§ 2.A. and D. of the Constitution.
