

Mashpee Veteran Banner Program



A Veteran Banner Committee, under the direction of the Mashpee Historical Commission, is sponsoring the placement of photos of Mashpee veterans on to banners to be displayed from the light poles in Community Park, across the street from town hall. With a total of 20 light poles in the park and using two veteran banners on each pole, a total of 40 veterans will be honored at a time. The banners will be displayed from approximately June through November. If more than 40 veterans photos are submitted, a lottery will determine the first 40 to be put on display. Those not drawn in the first lottery will be displayed during a future cycle. Any veteran who has lived in or is currently living in Mashpee is eligible. It is all inclusive. The veteran did not have to have enlisted from Mashpee, just that he or she is a veteran who lived in Mashpee or is currently living in the town and served honorably.
